## YES on Prop 30 Governor Brown's Tax Initiative to Fund Schools

## NO on Prop 32 Special Exemptions Act

Stop our California's democracy from being bought out! This has been referred to as "Citizens United on steroids". This deceptive initiative would increase the power of big corporations and Super PACs and eliminate the voices of working people in California politics. ## YES on Prop 37 Right to Know: Mandatory Genetically Engineered Food Labeling

This is all about labeling Genetically Engineered (GE) or Genetically Modified Organism (GMO) food. It's about our right to know as consumers. CEH is a strong advocate on this issue and we're fighting pesticide and GE seed corporations like Monsanto and DuPont who don't want us to know what we're eating. ## YES on Prop 39 Income Tax Increase for Multistate Business

We believe that multistate businesses should pay their fair share of taxes in CA. ## YES on Prop 40 Uphold the State Senate Redistricting Plan
